



## Update on the Brodie Bros.

Club representation was requested at a meeting on 8<sup>th</sup> Jan by the executors of the Brodie Estate, to discuss the upcoming Clearing Sale (Saturday, 9<sup>th</sup> Feb, at 9.30am). We had submitted an Expression of Interest in October, to ensure that certain vehicles would not go out of the district, or worse still, scrapped. Club members Ted Drake (Committee member & A Ford owner), Murray Murfett (Promotions Officer) and (President) Ian attended, along with representatives of the Wangoom Hall Committee, who have been given the job of organising and preparing for the sale. The executors agreed that examples of the Brodie Bros ingenuity and innovation should be kept out of the sale, to become a tribute display in the future. It is understood that the proceeds from the sale of the land will form the basis of a philanthropic trust. It is also understood that that the Trust would retain ownership of the vehicles etc. however no decisions have yet been made as to who would become the custodians. The items to be retained include several of the A Model vehicles & rural derivations, plus other suitable display material. To assist with the identification of A Model parts, Graeme McLeod, Ted Drake and Martin Dunstan along with other members have had a lot of fun separating the bits and pieces (e.g. nine A Model engines!). In addition, Martin has been taking images of the vehicles and spare parts in their sheds before removal, to keep a record and give any future display some context. Adam Edge has also taken aerial footage of the farm using his drone. The executors agreed to allow the vehicles to be displayed at our Lake Pertobe Day, and this was arranged by Willy Bentner. The Club has been invited to assist the Wangoom Hall Committee in setting up for the clearing sale and further working bees will continue until then.
