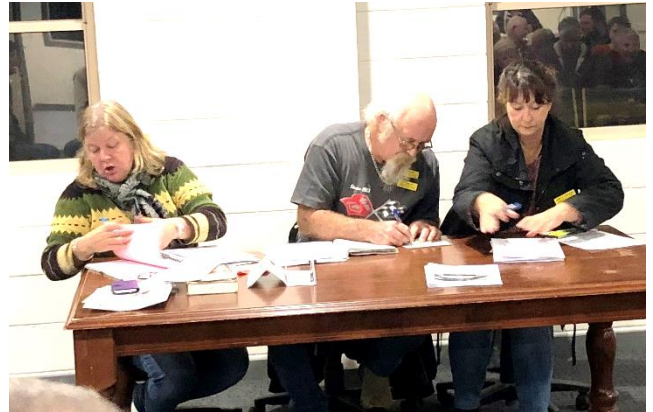


President's Report
