New or replacement Club name tags

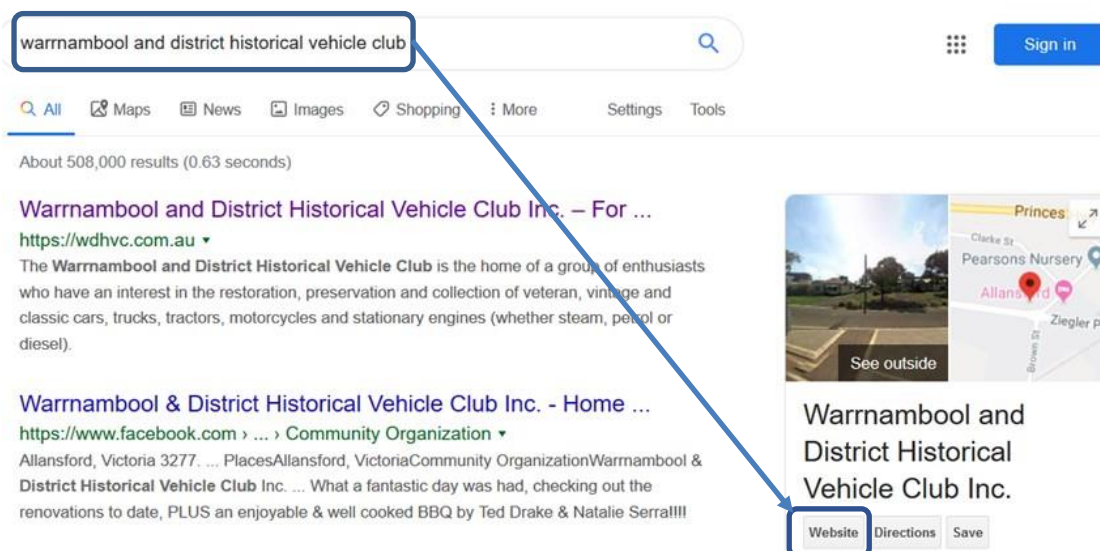
