


Some Interesting History

1672	Ferdinand Verbiest built a steam powered toy car that could carry one person.
1769	Cugnot built the first full size steam powered car.
1794	Robert Street patented an internal combustion engine powered by grain dust.
1794	Thomas Mead patented a gas powered internal combustion engine.
1808	Francois de Rivaz (Swiss) built a car powered by a hydrogen fuelled internal combustion engine.
1870	Siegfield Marcus (Austrian) built a car powered by a 2 stroke engine.
1872	George Brayton patented a liquid fuelled internal combustion engine.
1878	First recorded car race on 16 th July 1878 in the USA. 7 entries of which only one finished the course. IT took 33 hours and 27 minutes to claim a \$10 000 prize. The car was an Okrosh.
1886	Karl Benz patented the first practical motor carriage -1 cylinder 4 stroke.
1901	REO (Oldsmobile) started the first production line to build cars.






