Minutes of previous meeting: Moved to accept October Committee meeting minutes as printed in October newsletter: Graham Conn; 2nd Peter Carter. Carried.

Business Arising: Actions from last Committee meeting are first in General Business below.

Correspondence:

In: Newsletters from Newcomb, Lion (Sept and Oct), Victor Harbor. SWC monthly statement.

Email from Nhil Vintage Machinery Club thanking our Club from making donation during recent rally visit in October.

Reports

Treasurer: Account balances provided. Accounts received and payments made since September provided. Accounts for October listed for payment. Moved to approve accounts and pay invoices: Ross Millard; 2nd G. Houston. Carried.

Engine Committee: Cheese World visited and items very dusty. Next visit for cleaning. Graham, Murray, and Jack checked items for ownership and donations. Graham catalogued items and provenance. Museum may open March.

Club Captain: Australia Day to be just breakfast and no general meeting. At Kirkstall – by the playground.

Mid-week: Tomorrow to Simons at 2pm.

Community Service Coordinator: Nothing.

Federation Rep: Ashley reported Fed Zoom meeting last month: discussion about CPS issues including about handing back logbook when car is sold; what constitutes a Club (e.g., 1 person or 5 people??); CPS eligibility has stayed at 25 years which is out of step with other states; the lack of 15 day log books may cause some older cars to stay in shed; some CPS forms taken to VicRoads not being signed. For Bendigo swap will be looking for volunteers to help with COVID regs compliance. AHMS is looking to set up “Friends of Parliament Group” to discuss fossil fuels after 2030.

General Business:

- Kitchen servery blind: Quote received and already approved to proceed. Treasurer to pay 50% to go ahead.
- Pavers front of Clubrooms: Bring up at general meeting end of month for volunteers to start laying pavers.
- BBQ area upgrade: Suggestions to put a bench next to sink, change cladding on west wall to match extension with window, bench just outside the servery window. Further discussion same time as we do pavers.
- Garden sleepers: Purchased and working bee needed and ask for volunteers at general meeting.
- Office printer bought and installed. Treasurer to add to asset register.
- Xmas party (Dec 5th): BYO main meal, alcohol. Club provide pavs, plum pudding and soft drinks. Karen organising.
- QR Code obtained.
- Lake Pertobe display: Application submitted to WCC to hold event. Secretary had preliminary discussion with WCC who are likely to require us to display QR code, install fencing and check vaccination status of those entering display area. Moved that Club to respond to WCC that we would only proceed with display on basis of displaying QR code and log in sheets but no fences or checking of vaccination status: Moved: Ian Chislett; 2nd Peter Carter. Carried. Secretary to advise Jack Whitehead of WCC accordingly.
- Martin to liaise with Murray about street advertising if display goes ahead. Need to decide on who we sponsor for donations. Theme Austin Seven (100th anniversary). And need to decide if we are doing BBQ.
- Apply for Street trader: Ian. Do same type of BBQ as Bunnings (assuming we can hold event).
- November General meeting is on. 4 sq m per person and all vaccinated. President to notify in newsletter.

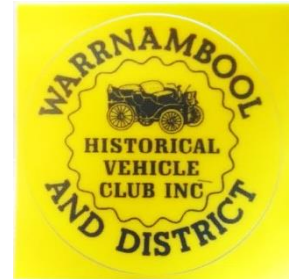

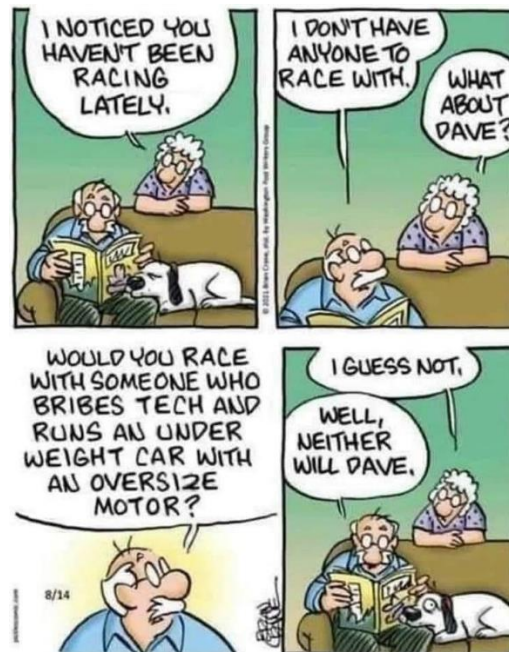
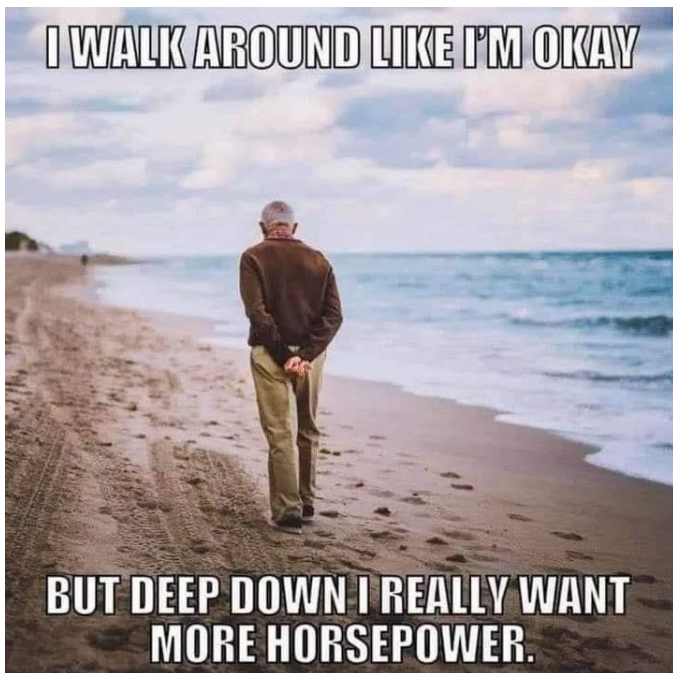
