



VALE Colin Joseph Williams


Colin Williams, a Life Member of WDHVC Inc., who contributed from the club's beginning in 1973, died on 10 December 2021, aged 93.

The Austin Sevens proved popular and represented a wide variety of body styes including a little open wheel racing car that was donated to the Austin Seven club by a former member. The feature display provided a good platform for that club to promote their forthcoming national rally to be based in Warrnambool this coming April. They are expecting 150 cars.







