President David Berner spoke of common sense politics around net zero emissions not wishy washy politics. Has spoken to fuel companies who said they would be around for a long time yet and have shareholders to look after.

On average in Australia, CPS cars travel 1000 kms a year and spend \$1200 a year on fuel and repairs etc. The runs out to rural pockets put money into the economy.

Zero emissions from 2050 starting from 2030. This subject needs to be discussed among club members and any ideas passed on to AHMF.

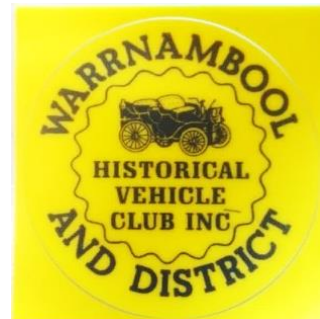

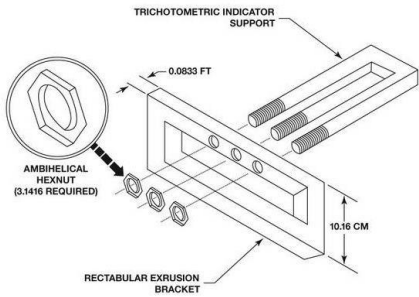
