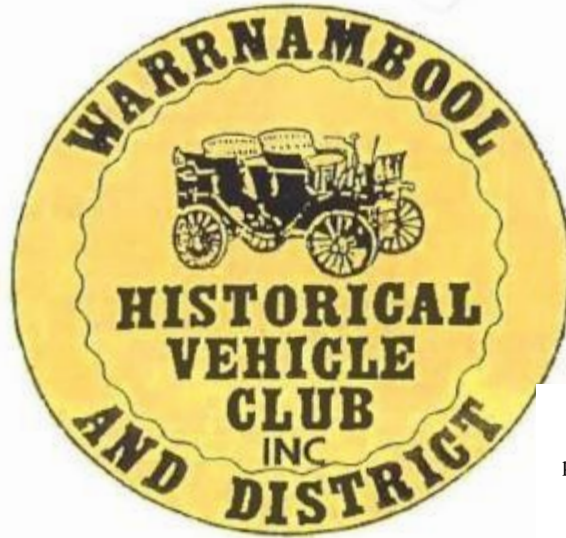


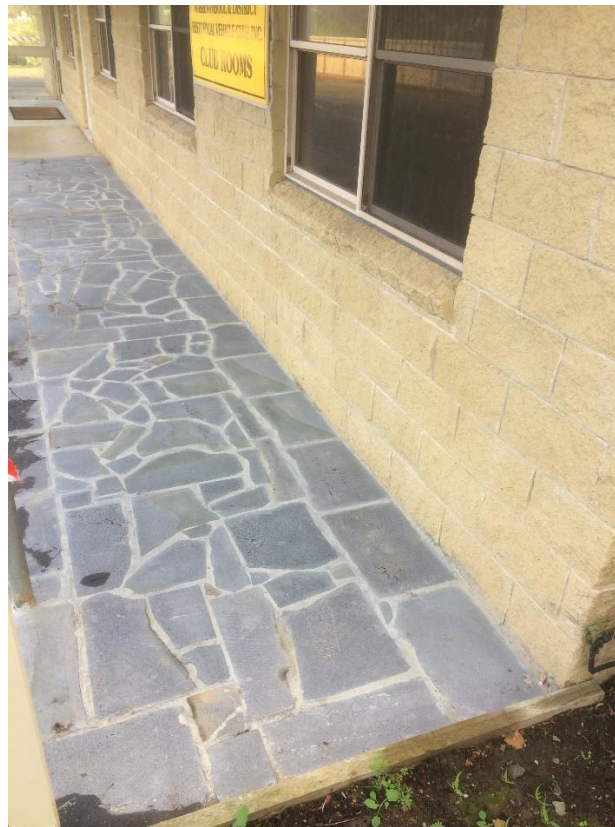

Federation Rep: Nothing.

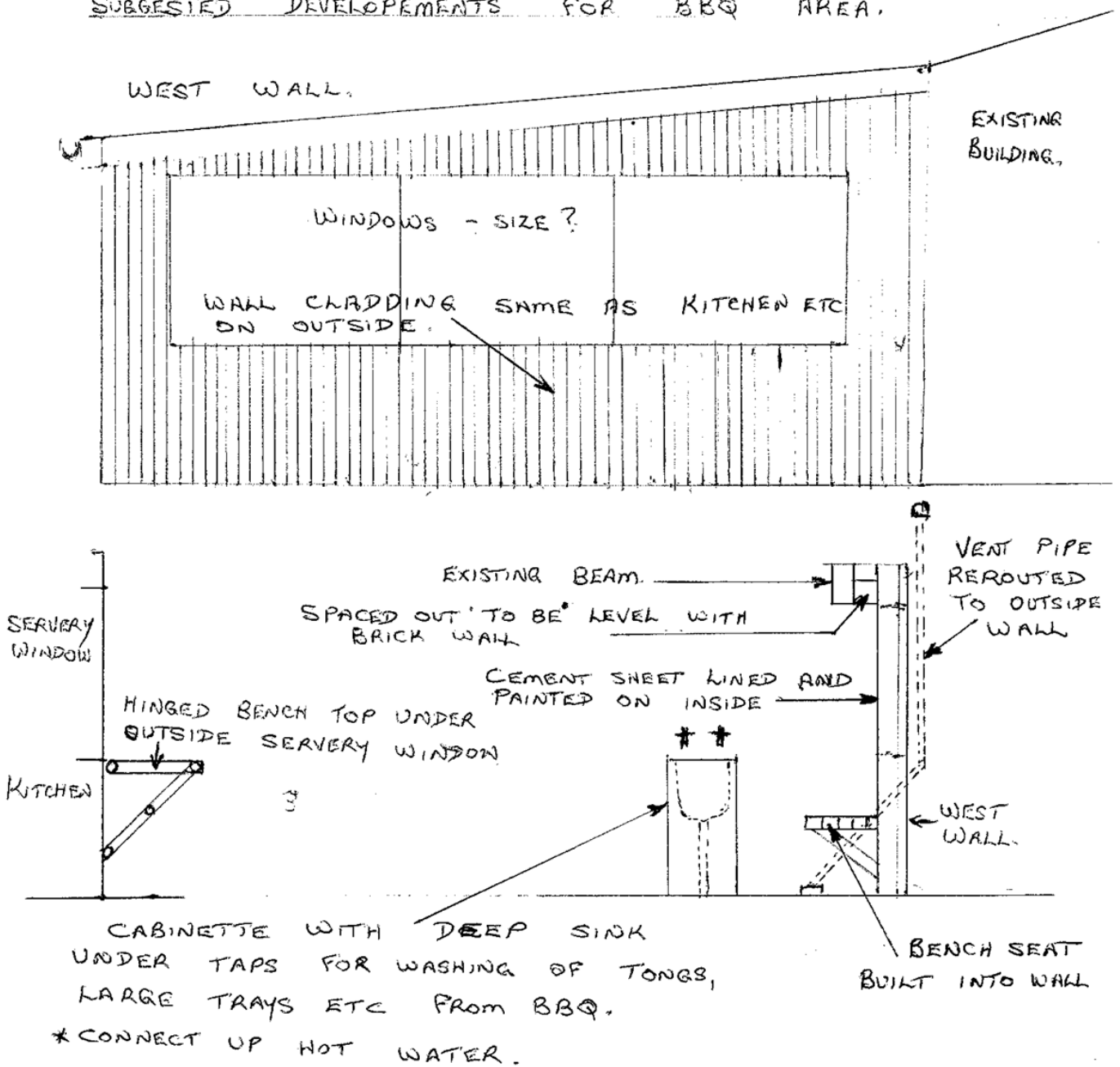
General Business:

A very big thank you to Ian Wilson for arranging the day also the Members at Cobden for their time and effort. It was disappointing more members never made the effort to attend.

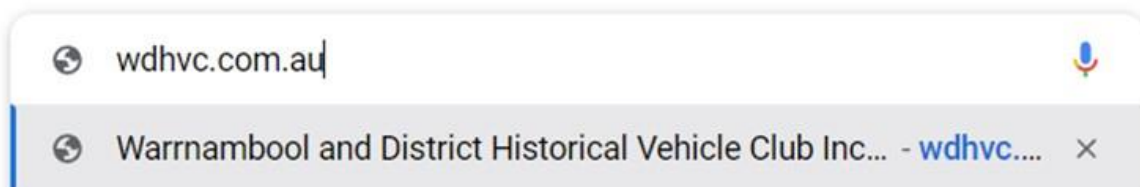
Since COVID our Club has become stagnant. We need to have new ideas introduced, more members taking interest in activities, and not being just a membership number, but active members.

1. Start by opening Google and type in the Club's website address: **wdhvc.com.au** – like this below....



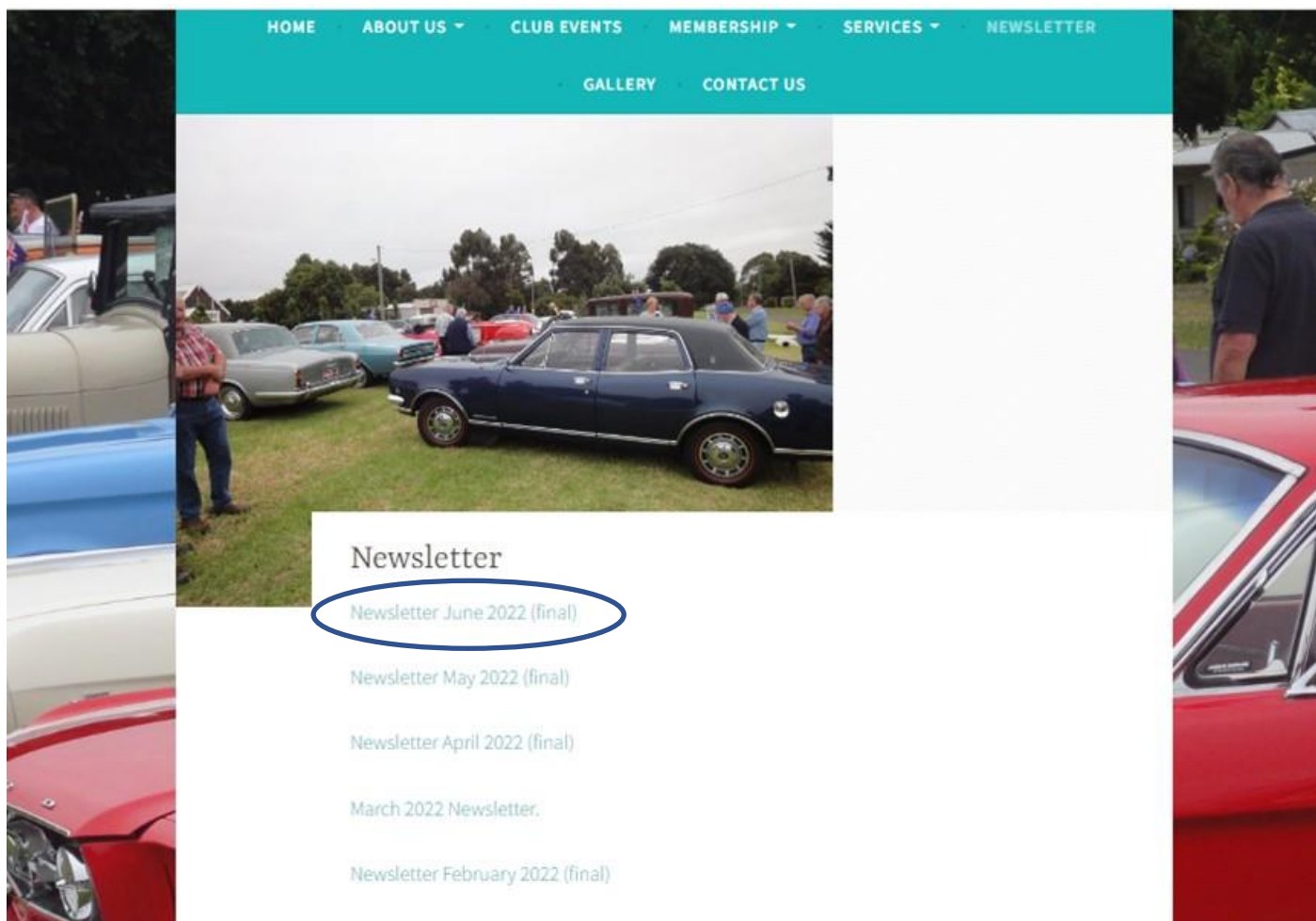
2. Press Enter and then you will see the Club's website home page and at the bottom is a blue task bar with various tabs and the one 3rd from right is **NEWSLETTER**.



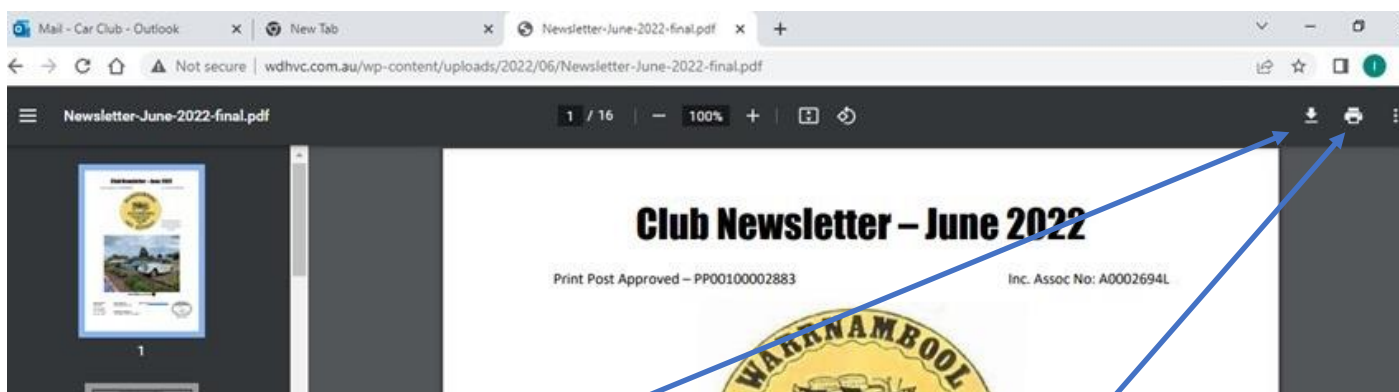
This is what that blue bar looks like in more detail....

Our Webmaster files newsletters about the same time they are sent to be printed which is a week before they get delivered by mail. You can print a hard copy for about one tenth what it costs the Club to print and mail it.

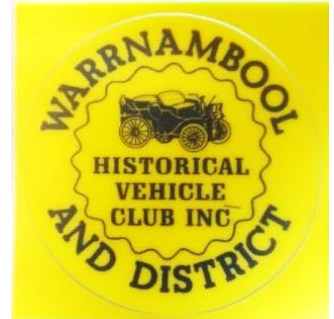
