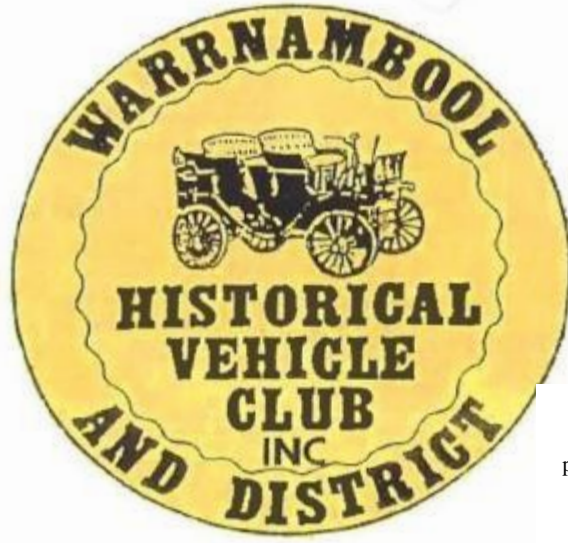

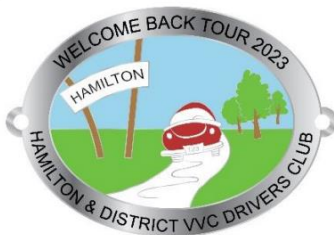

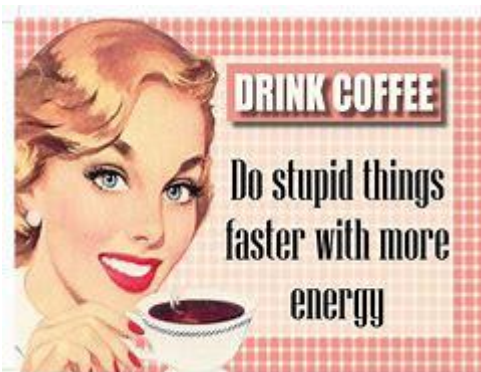
Good attendance from club members with their cars at Speedy Hodgson's funeral. A very personal service.

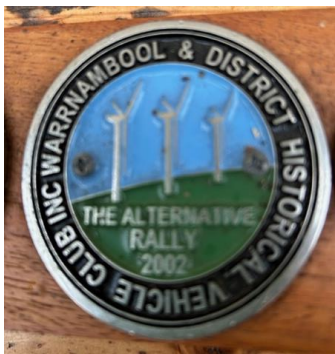


Easter Rallies

With the W&DHVC 50TH Anniversary Celebrations taking up the last weekend in March, our attention can turn to Easter and some reminiscing on what was once a stalwart of the club's annual program of events, its Easter Rally. From information gleaned from Graeme McLeod's history of the W&DHVC 1973 -1993, COGS AND COLLECTIONS, plus Newsletters of the past, it appears the first would have been in 1974 as the 1984 rally was described as the Tenth Easter Rally. For some time, the event was known as the Ideal Easter Rally. (Warrnambool won an Ideal City Award in 1928.) There were 108 participants in the 1984 event, including Modern Cars and Stationary Engine exhibitors. Participants came from far and wide and as well as the designated drive on the Saturday followed by a dinner, a Motorkhana was usually held on the Sunday at a venue such as the Winslow Reserve (photo below).



The last rally, being *The Lochard Experience* Easter Rally was held in 2004. It was decided that the club lacked the membership to continue with the significant effort involved and times were a-changing. Several clubs in the area still conduct annual rally's such as Hamilton's, Queen's Birthday weekend Rally. A collection of many of the Rally Badges that were minted for Warrnambool's events are displayed in the clubrooms.

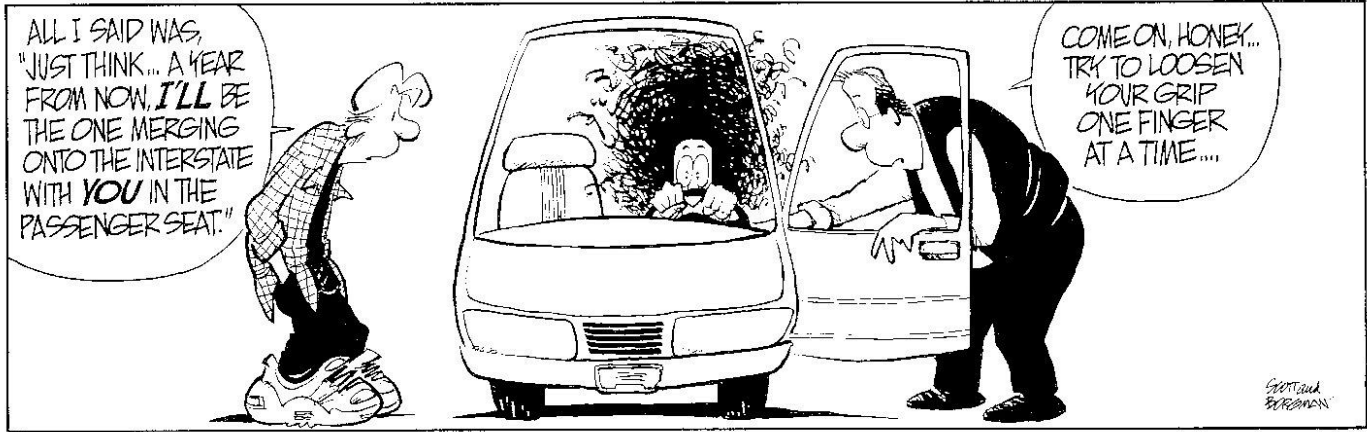
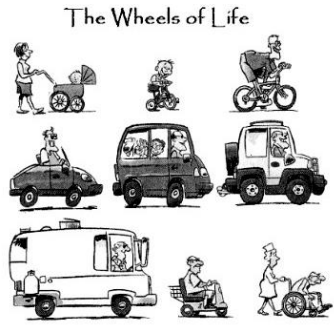
