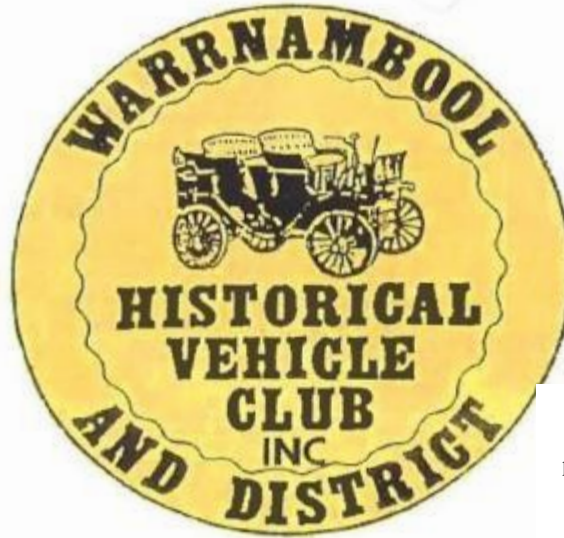

An article in The Warrnambool Standard accompanied by a photo of Dave Lee when he was 79 (and a quite young Member for Wannan David Hawker) reported that Dave Lee started collecting engines in the 1970's.

An era in engines

The steady beat of one of Dave Lee's 115 working antique engines drowned out much of yesterday's official opening of his exhibition — but the message was clear.

A lifetime of work was on display at the rear of his Koroit St home and the 40 people who gathered to see it were obviously impressed.

Dave Lee, 79, worked as a plumber, tinsmith and windmill mechanic before putting his knowledge to collecting engines.

He started collecting in 1970 when he retired and, as yet, he hasn't stopped.

The collection features antique

engines from throughout Victoria, interstate and England, America and Switzerland.

Forty-four brands are featured and Mr Lee values his pieces at more than \$100,000.

Many old-timers sorted through the collection yesterday.

Mr Lee said at least 14 of the engines had been saved from scrap metal heaps and been rebuilt.

The display will be open tomorrow from 10 a.m. until 4 p.m. and can be seen every Thursday to Sunday through the holiday season.

Mr Lee will conduct guided tours at 1 p.m. on these days.

All money raised will go to charity.

Dave had worked as a plumber, tinsmith and a windmill mechanic before putting his knowledge to collecting engines. At that stage he was

exhibiting his collection in a shed at the rear of his property in Koroit Street. Moving forward to around 2008 and following his passing, his family approached the W&DHVC regarding options to continue to display the collection. The club discussed the situation with the then Warrnambool Cheese & Butter management as to dovetailing the collection with Cheese World Museum. An arrangement was reached where Warrnambool Cheese & Butter would provide space in a building close to the existing museum complex with the Lee Family retaining ownership of the engines. The club would assist with the moving of the engines and arranging of the display for the enjoyment of all.

So, the move was made with club members lifting, cataloguing, and shifting the collection to a storage area at Cheese World. The engines were cleaned and, in most instances, run by club members and finally put into their present positions, labels made, and the fence erected. Large prints relating to early motoring days were ordered by the club and placed on the main wall for general interest. Club President at the time of negotiating, Brendan O'Shea, presided over the official opening of the display in 2009. The display is now opened upon request when club members are on duty at Cheese World although much of it can be seen through the glass doors. With over 100 engines on display, and some made in Warrnambool, Hamilton or Ballarat, there are many with interesting backgrounds. Take for example, the early 1900's Warrnambool built Bruce & McClure 12 hp engine that was used at the Warrnambool Town Hall to generate electricity for picture shows before State Electricity Commission power was connected. It was subsequently used for general farm work and purchased from Les Johnstone at Mailers Flat.

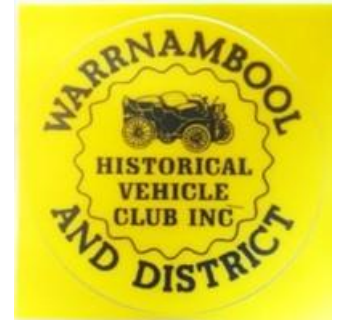

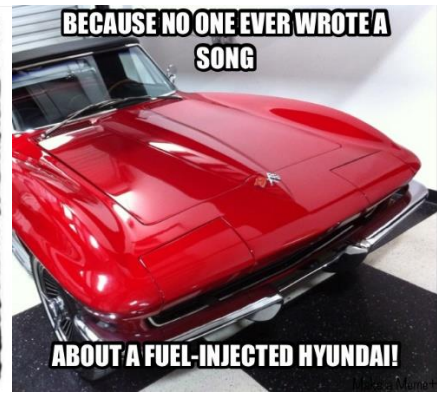
