President's Message

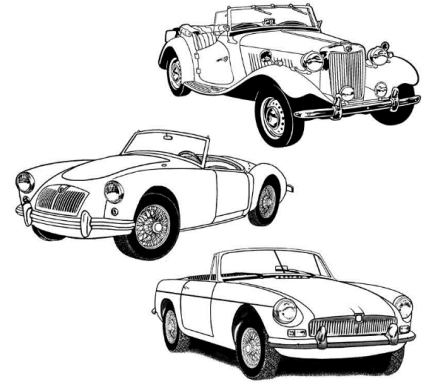
Hi All,

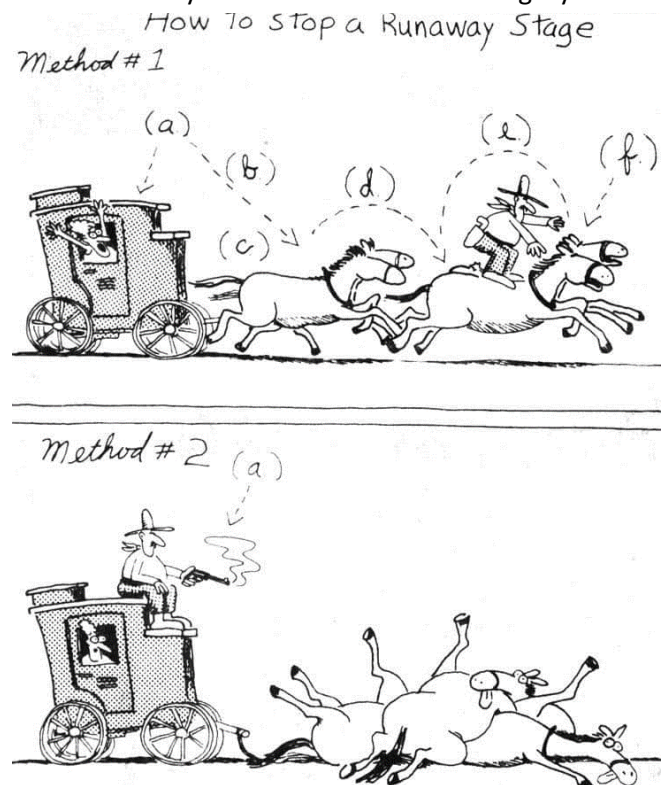

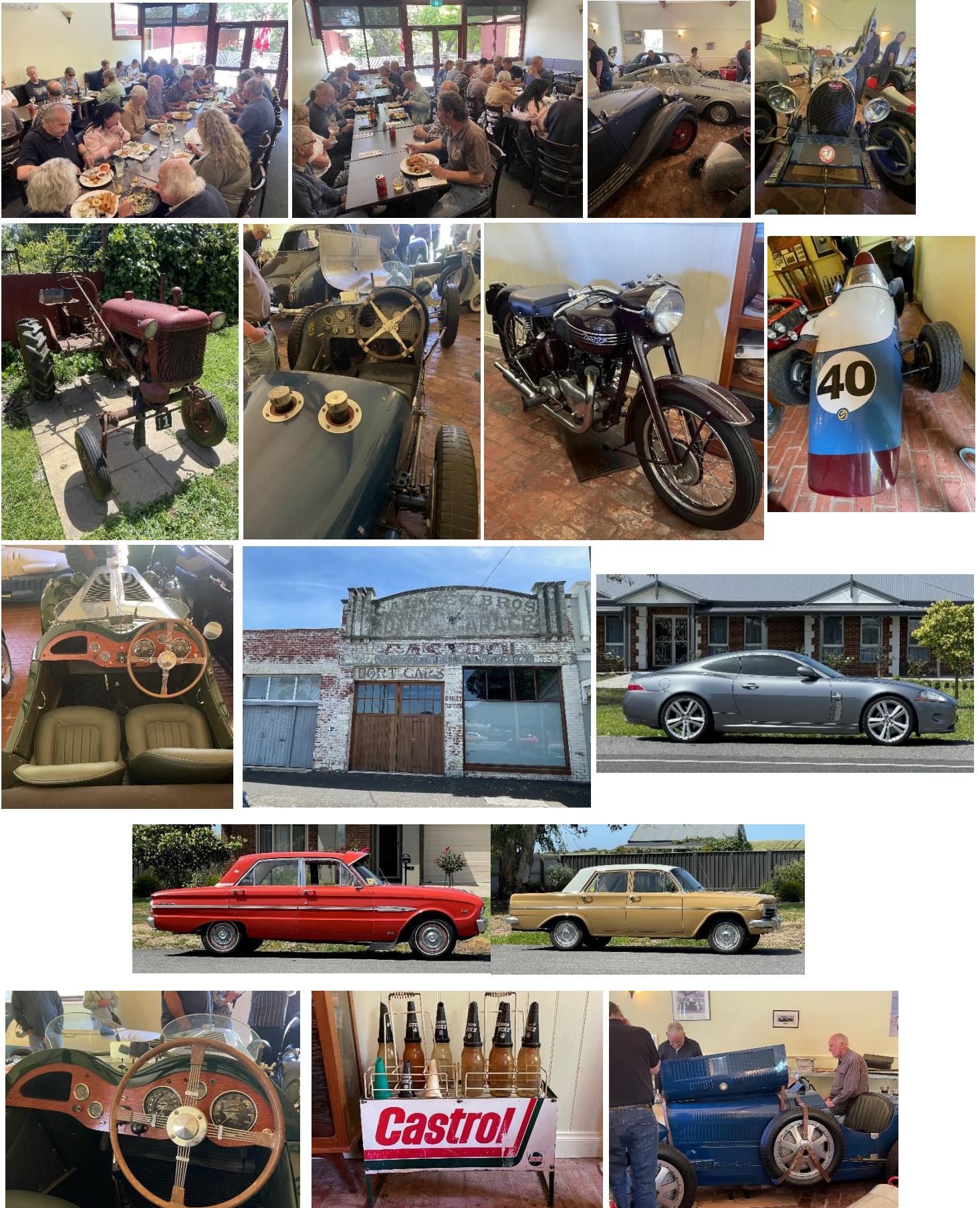

Display Days.

Without doubt probably the clubs most significant day each year is its Display Day. It is reported that the clubs first display of members vehicles was held on June 3rd 1973, at St John's School in Dennington. In the club's early days, a number of different venues were used and themes promoted, for example the Steam & Vintage Vehicle Display in 1980 at J. R. Brown's and a Brierly Steam Rally held on November 29th 1981. A two-day display was also held in the Port Fairy Drill Hall in 1981. A Jetty Flat display was held on January 9th 1983, and an early January weekend has become the norm with a Day from the Past held at the Warrnambool Show Grounds on January 6th 1985. The event has however become known as the Lake Pertobe Display Day and now utilizes the wonderful facilities of that area plus the opportunity to capture the attention of Summer holiday makers to the city. Each year a name is allocated to the day that draws attention to a certain feature such as a brand, an anniversary of a make or model or something similar, example's being, Roaring 20's, All things Holden and 50 years of Falcon.

The day is of course open to all vehicles and stationary engine set ups and outside entries are included. Gate donations over the years have aided various

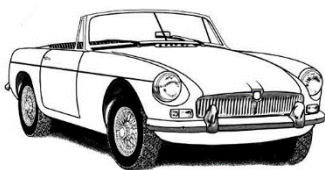


local charities and institutions such as the Warrnambool Base Hospital, for a number of years Camp Quality and the Warrnambool Surf Life Saving Club. In recent years the club has taken over from Rotary BBQ catering which has

helped raise the amount of money accumulated on the day considerably. It is a day when "all hands on deck" means the load of conducting the event is spread around.

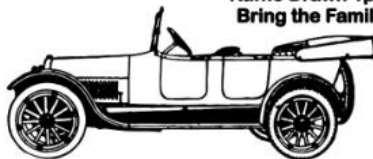
