

Club members have been invited to Arthur Byron's 90th birthday at Stawell. Check the details in the notice elsewhere in the newsletter. (see below)



When and how to pay subscriptions

Targa Classica in Warrnambool - March 19 & 20

The 4-day event started in Ballarat on March 18th and stopped in Warrnambool at the end of the second leg on March 19th. Next morning the cars converged on Flagstaff Hill at 7am for public car show and the first car was scheduled to leave at 9 am. There was a breakfast available, and the entrants were parked either on the hill inside Flagstaff Hill or out in the parking lot. Chilly morning but many locals as well as Targa drivers and

event stewards were on hand. Many of the cars were Italian but among the 177 cars marques were Bugatti, Porsche, Alfa Romeo, Ferrari, Jaguars, and some Australian classics including the Holden Sandman and Torana. The cars below left were mainly Jaguars and Porsche parked on the green close to the flagstaff and on the right were down in the village. The green 1930 Oakland




had a lot of trouble getting up the hill with lots of black exhaust smoke and backfiring and had to back down the road and take a run up – but they made it to the next stop!

At 9 am the cars were flagged away at 1-minute intervals with the 1927 Bugatti and the Oakland first. This 3rd stage was to Torquay and was won by the Bugatti and then the 4th and final stage was to Melbourne Fed Square.


